



## Internship Permission Form

Cape Fear Regional Theatre's Intern Program is designed to give area high school and college students the opportunity to learn valuable and practical skills in live theatre production. As part of this program, classes in various areas of technical theatre are given over the course of the year. In addition, interns are assigned to work various crew positions on our professional shows throughout the season. With consideration for the needs of any particular show and the conflicts of the interns, it is CFRT's goal that each intern works 2-3 productions completely.

Working the run of a show requires our interns to be at the theatre approximately 35 hours a week (nights and weekends) for 4-5 weeks at a time. Knowing that this is a significant contribution of their time, we try not to schedule any intern for 2 full productions back to back.

Prior to the start of each production, CFRT sends a calendar to each intern with the show schedule listed. These calendars allow interns to indicate any scheduling conflicts that they might have with that particular show schedule and are used to determine work assignments based on the needs of the production. We encourage you to look over these calendars with your child when they are sent.
