Each year, CFRT reaches more than 49,000 people through six award winning mainstage productions, a recurring community-based holiday production, Blues-n-Brews (an annual fundraiser - with beer!), and a broad range of education and outreach programs. CFRT's building has a 285-seat mainstage theatre, scenic and costume shops, and administrative offices, as well as an adjacent education center and off-site storage warehouse. ## **Master Carpenter**

Reports to: Production Manager/Technical Director

Time Commitment: Full-time Hourly (40 hrs per week) Occasional nights and weekends required.

Their primary focus is to build our 6 Mainstage Shows, remount our Holiday Show and construct a modular set for our summer camps. They also assist with events, such as our annual Blues N Brews fundraiser.
