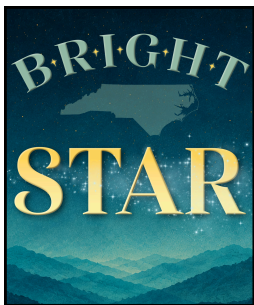


Bright Star

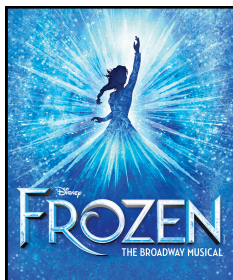
starts as chaos becomes something heartfelt and new, proving that even the most unlikely participants can rediscover the true meaning of Christmas.
